EVENT INFORMATION

Parking

Parking at Black Creek is free for event attendees. A code will be provided at the event Registration table that can be used to leave the parking lot.

Entrance Fee

Park entrance to Black Creek Pioneer Village grounds is free for attendees.

Event Location

Signs will direct you from the Black Creek Pioneer Village Visitor's Centre entrance to the Event Pavilion (about a 5-minute walk). Site maps are available at the Visitor's Centre if required.

Accessibility

The Black Creek parking lot has wheelchair accessible parking located approximately 80 metres from the Visitor's Centre entrance. There is a passenger drop-off/pick-up circle in front of the main entrance doors that event attendees are welcome to use, if needed.

Wheelchairs are not available on site. If you require a wheelchair or another assistive device, please ensure you bring your own to the event.
