Event Information

Parking

Parking is available on-site in Parking lot B, please see the map (attached separately) for details.

Transit

If you plan to take public transit, please be aware that transit cannot access Parking lot B or the event space directly. It is recommended to get off at the intersection of Rexdale Boulevard and Queen's Plate Drive. From there, you will need to walk a short distance to Parking lot B, then board a shuttle bus to the event space.

Shuttle Buses

Shuttle buses will run from Parking lot B to the event space providing drop-off and pick-up service. They will run every 5-10 minutes at the start and end of the event.

During the event, the shuttle buses will not be running regularly. Instead, one or two will be available for those wishing to leave early or that arrive late.

Event Location

Signs and wayfinding staff will direct you to Parking lot B and to the event space.

Horse Racing

A representative will be on-site at the event location to provide information about horse racing. Please be aware that betting services will not be available at the event space.

Accessibility

Wheelchairs will not be available on site. If you require a wheelchair or another assistive device, please ensure you bring your own to the event.

Should you require accessible parking located closer to the venue, please contact us in advance.
