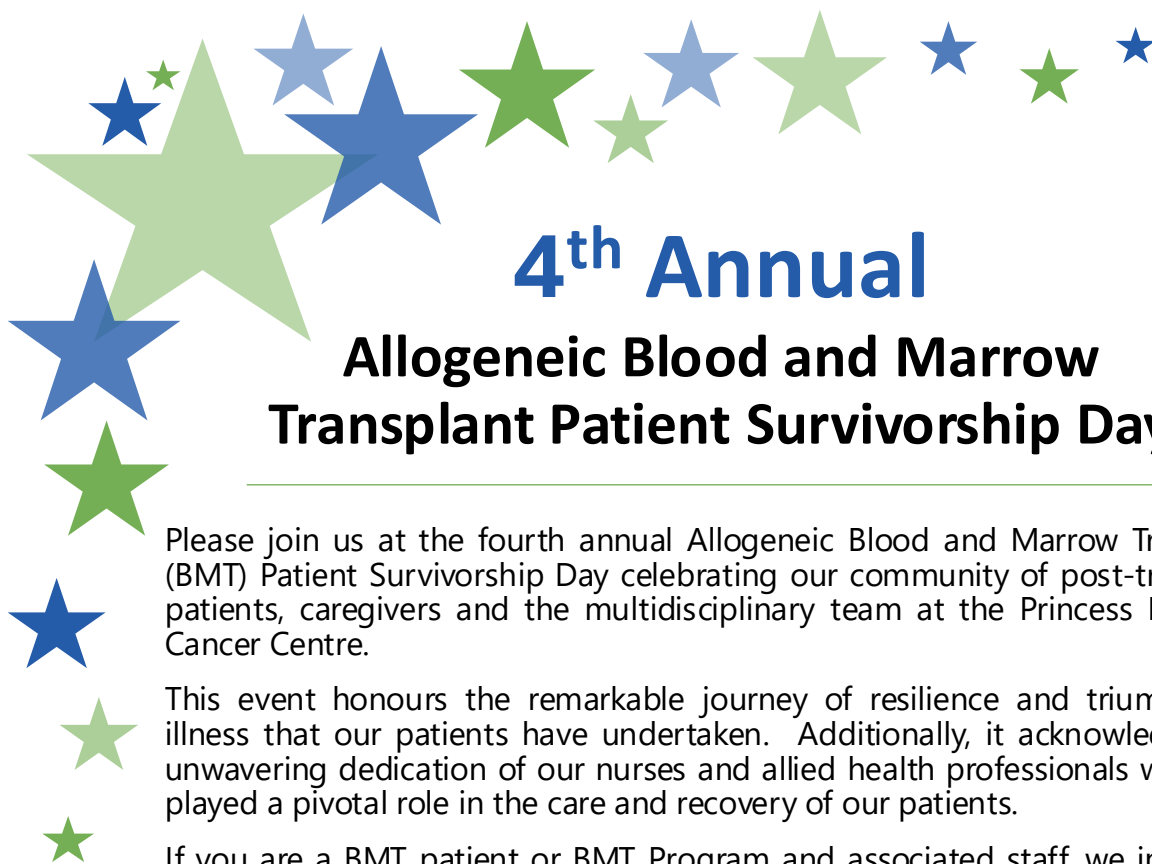




4th Annual

Parking

Parking is available on site. Please note that while there are paid parking meters around the venue lot, you do not need to use these as **parking is free for event patrons.**

Accessibility

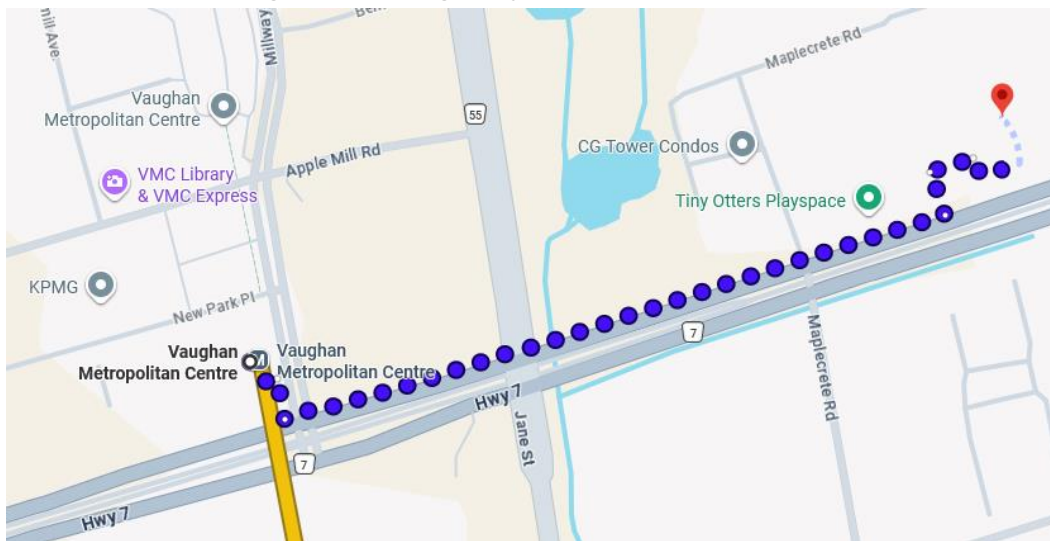
Wheelchairs will not be available on site. If you require a wheelchair or another assistive device, please ensure you bring your own to the event.

Several accessible parking spots are available by each of the venue entrances. There are elevators inside the venue for access to the 2nd floor.

Transit

If you plan to take public transit, please take Line 1 to Vaughan Metropolitan Centre Station. From there, proceed to the venue one of the following ways:

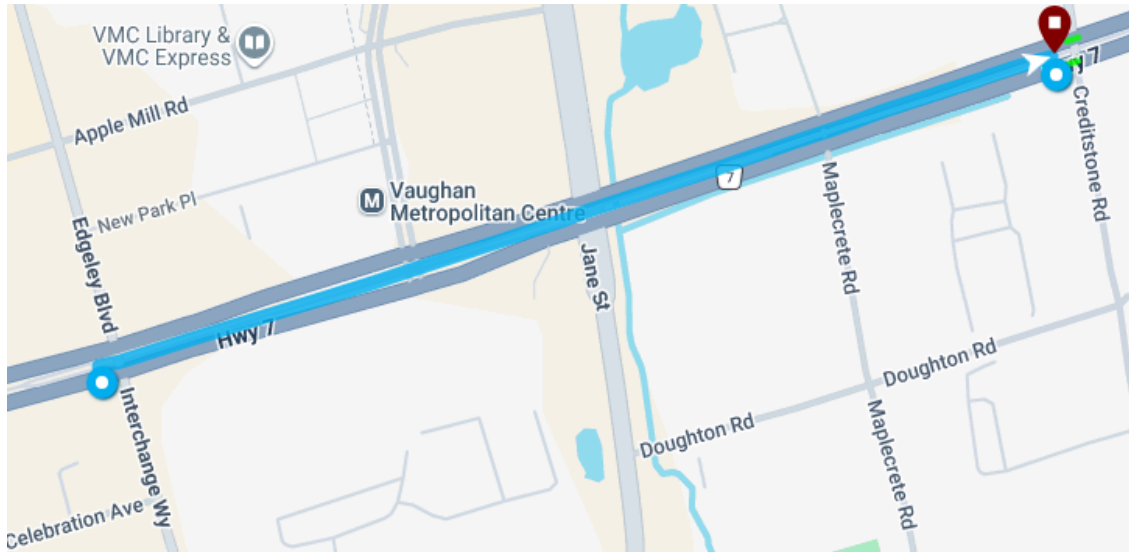
Option 1: Heading east on Highway 7, there is a 15min direct walk to the



Option 2: Exit Vaughan Metropolitan Centre station. Walk west along Highway 7. Cross at Edgely Blvd, then again at Highway 7 to reach the traffic island in the centre. The bus stop is located on the south side of the island. Board the westbound **York Regional Transit bus Route 77**. Get off at the Highway 7 / Creditstone Road stop. There is another short walk (approx. 1min) from there to the event space.

Option 3: Alternatively, the Viva Orange bus route can also be taken for one stop. However, note that the boarding location is at Highway 7 and Commerce Street, which is a slightly longer walk west from the subway station.
